THE ISLAND OF SUSAK

Lošinj and its islands form a unique archipelago. After a pleasant one-hour boat trip, you arrive to the island of Susak. Susak is a unique island in its appearance. Thick layers of fine yellow sand have been piled up by prehistoric winds on a limestone slab. The inhabitants planted around their agricultural goods reeds, whose roots, in search of water, penetrate deep into the soil and protected it from erosion. The residents of Susak were wine growers. Once 96% of the island were vineyards. Susak offers sandy and shallow beaches suitable for children. After swimming and lunch, the boat trip continues and after 1 hour and 15 minutes, you arrive on the island of Ilovik.

THE ISLAND OF ILOVIK

The two neighboring islands, Ilovik and St. Peter, are the extension of the southern part of Lošinj separated by the strait called "Door of Ilovik". The island Ilovik has a surface of 5.8 km² and 15.4 km of coastline. Only one village is located on the island. A canal approximately 2.5 km long and 300 m wide divides the two islands Ilovik and St. Peter. The port protects yachts and smaller boats from any stormy winds and offers a secure harbor. The island has a Mediterranean vegetation, with different types of flowers, oleanders, palms and eucalyptus trees. The island is often referred to as the flower island.
